RESOLUTION ON PURPOSEIVE RESERVE

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Kendall County Health Department Governance, held on the 16th day of May 2017, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the full-time-equivalent of service providers has been held flat through the fastest growth period in Kendall County history and services are steadfastly provided through the dedicated staff/volunteers working in the diverse sectors of community action, behavioral health, environmental health, community health, emergency preparedness, & program support; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department reserve; dedicated for the sustainability of health and human services, is necessary for the solvency of the Health Department; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Kendall County Board of Health officially expresses deep appreciation for the diverse precious persons within our community and so aspires to keep no less than 2.5 million in reserve to use throughout the coming months in order to protect and sustain such said commitment.
