# **Funds Available for Energy Assistance**

Kendall County Health Department's Kendall-Grundy Community Action Services has funds available to assist low income households in meeting their immediate home energy needs by paying a portion of winter energy bills to prevent service interruptions, while providing education on home energy conservation and other opportunities to achieve and maintain financial self-stability. We also offer a free energy conservation kit with that includes helpful tips on further conserving energy, intended to help lower your energy costs.

To qualify for this assistance on your gas and your electric bills, households must have an income equal to or less than 150 percent of the poverty level as defined in the 2019 poverty guidelines and provide required documentation during the scheduled appointment. Please see requirements below.

#### 2019 Poverty Guidelines:

## Required documentation for appointment:

- 1. Social Security cards for every household member
- 2. Proof of income for the last 30 days for anyone 18 years or older in the household.
- 3. Current gas and electric bill
