Kendall County has 8 Cases of Coronavirus Disease

The Kendall County Health Department (KCHD) is reporting three new cases of Coronavirus Disease (COVID19). A male in his 30s and two females; one in her 40s and the second in her 50s tested positive for the coronavirus 2019 disease. This brings the total of Kendall County residents who have tested positive to eight at this time.

Listed below are some helpful reminders.



PLEASE DO:

- Keep washing your hands, with soap and water for 20 seconds
- Keep social distancing, stay 6 feet from other people
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
- Stay home when sick
- Clean and disinfect your cell phone
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces
- Reach out to family or neighbors via phone or video chat
- Go for walk while maintaining social distancing
- Find ways to exercise within your home
- Explore museums and parks online
